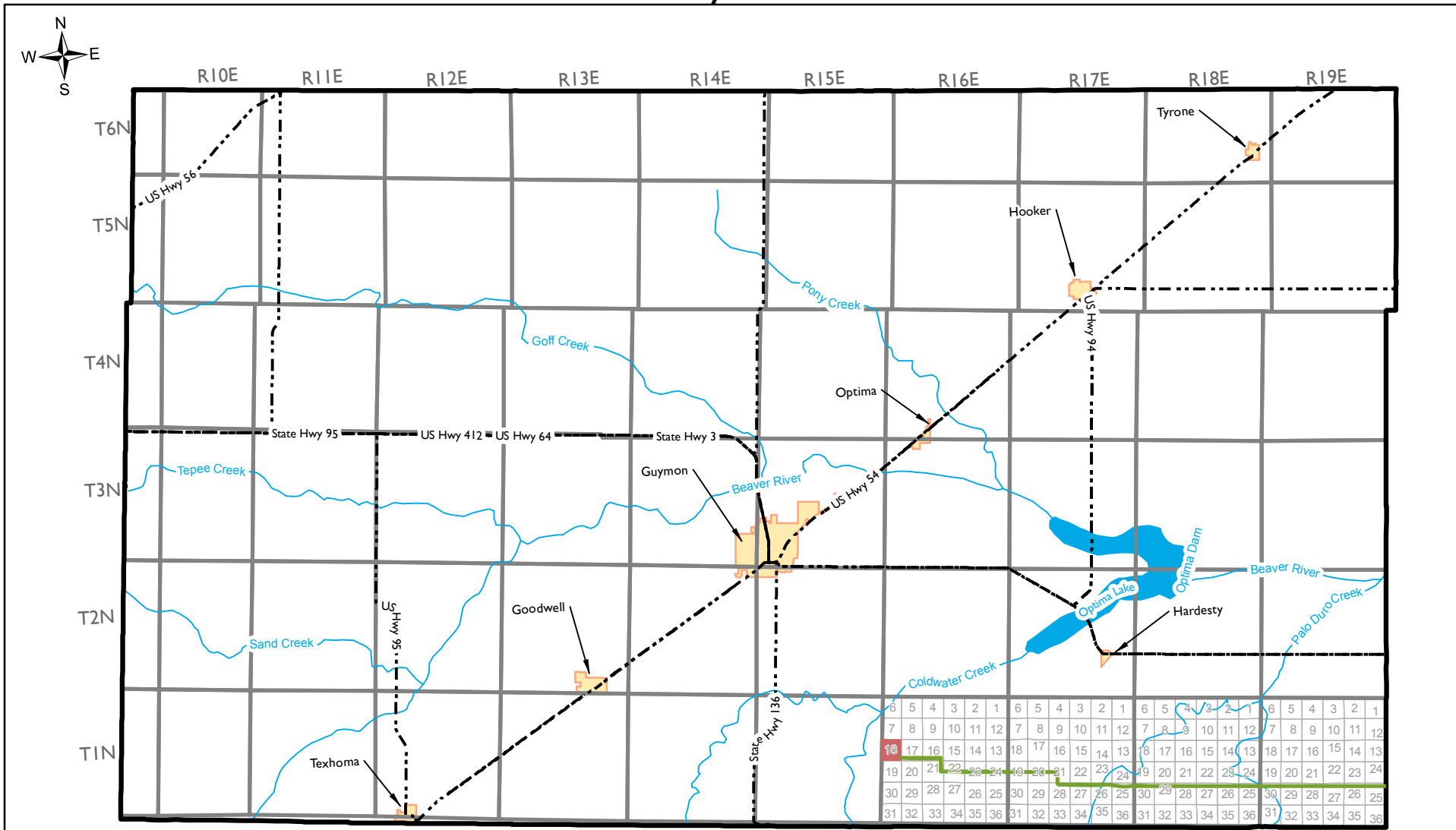








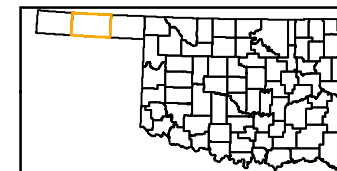


# Texas County, Oklahoma

**Note:** This map shows the location for the preferred route for the direct current transmission line and Oklahoma converter station selected by DOE in its Record of Decision (ROD). In most places, the final right-of-way for the direct current transmission line will be 150 to 200 feet wide. Minor adjustments can still be made to the final location of the right-of-way within the 1000-foot-wide preferred route selected by DOE in its ROD based on landowner input, field surveys, permitting, engineering design, and other factors.
